Local Intervention Fire Education (LIFE) is an exciting youth engagement programme offering young people the unique opportunity to learn a range of skills through working alongside London Fire Brigade. It is an intensive five-day course for 14–17 year olds, held at a fire station in your area of London.





SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

The course mimics the real job of a firefighter as participants take part in a range of activities which include using ladders, breathing apparatus equipment, and learning casualty rescue techniques. At the end of the week, parents, carers and professionals are invited to attend the young person's passing out ceremony to showcase what they have achieved.

Young people who have completed the LIFE course leave feeling motivated, with a new sense of direction and positive aspirations for their future. Some of them even go on to become firefighters!

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Helps young people discover their unfulfilled potential.
- Builds their confidence and self-esteem.
- Improves team work and social skills.
- Improves discipline and the individual's work ethic.
- Teaches responsibility, respect and leadership from positive role models.
- Improves an understanding of consequences and making positive choices.
- Improves their employability and motivates them to build aspirations for their future.
