As we routinely get asked for information about the number of lift entrapments attended by the Brigade, we have published this data on the [London Datastore](#) to assist those who require it.

The data is provided for three calendar years (36 months) and is updated monthly. If you are looking for a particular building/address and this does not appear in the list, you can assume that the Brigade has not attended a 'shut in lift' release at the address.
