Our Fire Safety Regulatory (FSR) team have confirmed that Brent Council is the lead authority for these premises. I have attached the correspondence sent to Brent Council, by the LFB FSR team, in relation to their re-inspection.

This is a convert house of 3 floors and basement. There are 7 bedsit rooms with shared cooking and bathroom facilities. A previous ENFORCEMENT NOTICE was issued in FEB of 2018 (28/226942/ere) however this doesn't appear to have been followed up. Brent LALO was able to confirm that this property was a known HMO having previously been issued with a HMO Licence however as it was private accommodation they couldn't confirm current licence status. Would need to confirm during office hours.
