Response:

The Health and Safety team have provided the answers below on Hearing protection in the LFB.

Whether your firefighters are provided with hearing protection? – Yes.

- if so, what type, when that was implemented and how often they wear it - All firefighters are issued with personal hearing protection, the type is 3M E.A.R Ultrafit 20. This was implemented in 2007.

It is not possible to assess how often they wear hearing protection as it depends on the type of incident they attend.

- if not, why that is deemed unnecessary?
